## Troubleshooting a Failed Biological Indicator (BI) Spore Test

- Check for Operator Error
- Do Not Overload the Sterilizer
  - o Check Manufacturer's Instructions for Use on Proper Loading/Unloading
  - Stack Perforated Cassettes Side to Side vs Flat
  - o Stack Pouches Side to Side in a Pouch Rack for Better Ventilation
- Place the BI in the Most Challenging Area of the Sterilizer
  - o In the Middle/Center of Gravity Displacement Autoclaves (Cool Pocket)
  - o Near the Door for Dynamic Air Removal Autoclaves (Possible Air Leakage)
- Re-Run a New BI Test
- Mail in Results or Incubate In-Office
- Check Results of Second Test
- If Failed Again
  - Take Sterilizer Out of Service
  - Consult Service Technician
  - Consult Sterilization Log Book
  - o Retrieve Instruments That Were Potentially Not Sterilized and Re-Process
    - **❖** Generally, BI Failures are a Result of Operator Error
